Election Day this year will be November 8, 2016 with the polls open from 6 a.m. until 8 p.m. Enclosed with this mailing are our election recommendations. The following are important dates for our members concerning this year's election:

October 18, 2016 - Deadline to register to vote in the November General Election.

November 1, 2016 - Deadline to apply to receive mail-in ballot (Vote by Mail) application by mail (for the General Election).

November 7, 2016 - Deadline for <u>in-person</u> mail-in ballot (Vote by Mail) application (for the General Election).

We are enclosing extra copies of this letter for you to post at your work locations and/or to distribute to members. In addition the above information as well as voter registration and vote by mail (VBM) applications can be accessed through the web at the www.nj.elections.org.

The recommendation of Hillary Clinton for President was made by SMART General President Sellers and the SMART General Executive Council. We know that many of our

members are thinking of voting for her opponent, Donald Trump. We would warn you and those members to look at the records of both candidates. Hillary Clinton has served as a U.S. Senator and Secretary of State and during the Presidency of her husband, Bill Clinton, had a front row seat in the White House as policy decisions were made and legislation enacted that led to a budget surplus and economic prosperity for our nation.
